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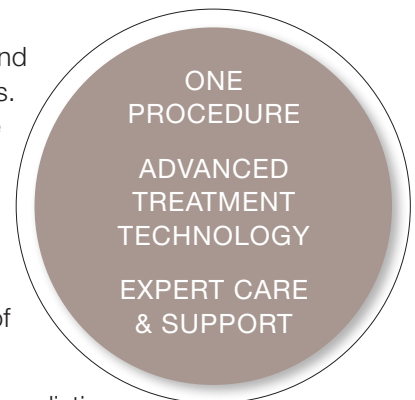
BREAST CANCER TREATMENT IN ONE DAY

At the Center for Cancer Care we understand the emotional stress and physical strain that multiple radiation treatments can have on patients. Early stage breast cancer patients who meet specific criteria have the option to receive a nationally renowned one-day treatment close to home, eliminating months of travel, disruption and anxiety.

Intraoperative Radiation Therapy (IORT) is a breast cancer treatment option in which radiation treatment can be administered in a single dose at the time of surgery. This eliminates the standard procedure of five to seven weeks of daily radiation.

IORT is performed by a collaboration of specialists including physicists, radiation oncologists and a fellowship-trained breast surgeon. As with all breast cancer treatments at the Center for Cancer Care, patients have a designated patient navigator to guide them through the process from diagnosis to final treatment.
