

## Visitation Policies and Shared Commitments

**Welcome.** This document provides important information to provide guidance during this time. Note: Personal Representatives are not visitors.

- Inpatients (with the exception of patients with Covid or Covid(PUI)) may have two visitors (over 12 if accompanied by an adult) at a time with the length of each visit to be determined by the inpatient staff.
- Family Center: Patients may have two support people present for their length of stay. We ask that these two be the same people. They will be identified in the hospital with either a baby band or a visitor sticker. If patient has a certified Doula, this person would not count as a support person. The Family Center will have visiting hours from 2 pm to 5 pm daily. Immediate sibling(s), accompanied by an adult are permitted. Other children under the age of 18 will not be allowed at this time.
- Patients, visitors and Personal Representatives are required to wear masks at all times while in any of our buildings.
- In compassionate care situations (such as end-of-life), decisions about visitation will be made collaboratively with the health care team, patient, and their loved ones, on a case-by-case basis.
- There are no changes to permitting entrance of a personal representative, legal guardian or designated support person.
- Emergency Department, Outpatient Areas and Core Practices Patients may have one person accompany them to their appointment, procedure, test, etc.
- In the case of outpatient surgeries /procedures, the visitor will be permitted to stay through the patient's recovery period.
- The cafeteria is open to staff, patients and visitors.

### **Shared Commitments to ensure the health and safety of everyone for those that may enter Hospital Departments or Core Offices**

**We will:**

- Screen 100% of staff daily to ensure they are symptom-free
- Test all hospital patients for the presence of active infection
- Require everyone to wear a proper mask
- Wash our hands and wear protective attire
- Practice social distancing
- Ensure that our facilities and equipment are clean and safe for everyone

**You will:**

- Not enter the hospital or Core office if not feeling well and provide accurate information about your health and compliance with CDC COVID-19 recommendations
- Wear a hospital-approved facemask **at all times**. If you need to eat or drink please do so outside the building.
- Wash/Sanitize your hands on arrival and when entering and leaving a room.
- Maintain six feet of distance between you and others where possible
- Follow the requests and guidance of staff in all situations
- Collaborate with the care team to share concerns or ways we can meet your expectations
