ADVANCEMENTS IN PROSTATE CANCER TREATMENT

Exeter Hospital's Center for Cancer Care is on the forefront of prostate cancer treatment with a new 5 day radiation treatment option for men with early stage prostate cancer. Traditional radiation treatment is 8 weeks, with 42 treatments, and/or surgery. This gives men in the early stages an additional option to treat the cancer in 5 treatments and not have to worry about it anymore. To learn if this treatment is right for you, talk to your urologist or call the Center for Cancer Care at 603-580-7337.

Additionally, we recently used funds that were philanthropically donated to purchase two new urology technologies. The Uronav Fusion Biopsy system allows Core Urologists to use MRI images of the prostate to perform targeted prostate biopsies. In the past, it was unheard of to be able to sample a specific abnormal area of the prostate. The new technology allows the doctor to get a more precise biopsy. The second technology, which uses the same equipment, is for men who will undergo radiation treatment for

prostate cancer. We will now offer SpaceOAR Gel which can be injected between the prostate and the rectum to protect the rectum from radiation exposure and injury during prostate cancer treatment. For more information, call Core Urology at

Advanced Care for Pediatric Dentistry

Core Pediatric Dentistry is now using innovative laser technology for soft tissue procedures such as on the gums and under the tongue. This laser is used instead of traditional scalpel techniques. With the laser, there is little to no bleeding and reduced swelling and pain. In most cases, sutures are not even needed. NEW PLAISTOW HEALTH BREAKS GROUND



Construction recently began on the new Plaistow Health office building at 127 Plaistow Road, which will provide expanded space in one convenient location for Core Physicians and Exeter Hospital services that are currently located at two other Plaistow sites. The practices located here will include **Core Physicians primary care**, along with **Exeter Hospital Rehabilitation Services** and **Pediatric Rehabilitation**. Core Physicians' rotating specialty services at Plaistow Health include **orthopedics**, **podiatry** and **cardiology**, with additional specialties to follow. Exeter Hospital X-ray services and Core Physicians lab services will also be located onsite for patient convenience. The building is expected to open in summer 2020 for these services, with Core Pediatric & Adolescent Medicine and the additional Core Physicians specialty practices moving in the following year. The new design also includes space for **walk-in urgent care**, which is currently being developed as a new service.
