

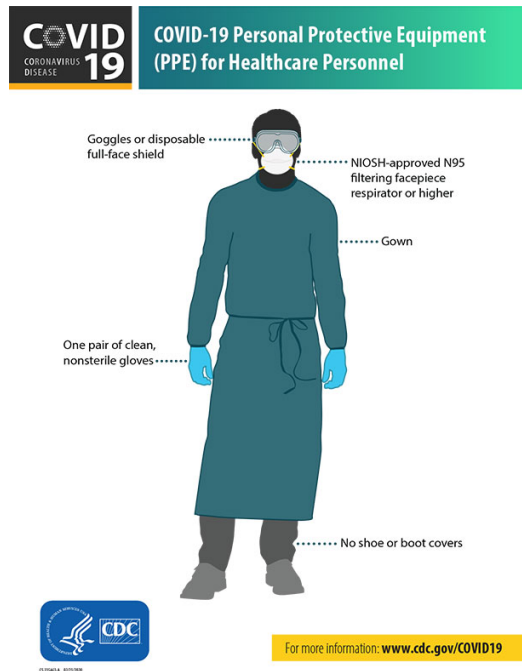
COVID 19 sample collection

Q: Who will perform the testing?

A: Testing is going to be performed by volunteer nurses, paramedics or EMT staff.

Q: What should you expect during testing?

A: The staff performing the test will be wearing personal protective equipment, which includes a mask, face shield, gown and gloves, as shown in the picture below.



- Personal protective equipment is used to prevent possible spread of infection to others.
- The team member will collect **one sample** from **your nose**. The collection process may be uncomfortable and lead to sneezing or coughing.

Q: How will you get your result?

A: You will be contacted by a member of Exeter Hospital with your test results.

Q: When will you get the result?

A: The results would be available in approximately three to five days of having the sample collected on weekdays, it may take longer on weekends.
