Family Center Receives Silver Level AACN Beacon Award

Congrats to the staff of Exeter Hospital's Family Center, that was recently honored with the American Association of Critical Care Nurses' (AACN) Silver Level Beacon Award for Excellence! Not only is our Family Center one of only two obstetrics units in the country to have received the award, but Exeter is the ONLY hospital in New Hampshire to have received a Beacon Award — three to be exact, as our ICU and PCU are also recipients. The award recognizes unit caregivers who successfully improve patient outcomes and align practices with the AACN's six standards for healthy work environments. Units that achieve the three-year designation meet national criteria consistent with Magnet™ Recognition, the Malcolm Baldrige National Quality Award, and the National Quality Healthcare Award.
